Whatever You Do To Least Of My Brethren

President's Message by Phil Arnsby

The neighbours next door consist of a woman, her live-in-boyfriend and her two daughters age 12 and 14. Your quiet area changed when they arrived. Almost immediately there was turmoil. You could hear loud fights day and night. One day you heard sobbing from the yard next door and you came face to face with your neighbour. She was about 30 and she attempted to conceal her black eyes and swollen and bruised face. You asked if she needed help and she broke down in tears. She said she felt trapped and terrified and that she and her daughters were suffering physical and sexual abuse. The boyfriend had threatened to harm all of them if they dared to go to the police.

What would you do? It is likely that most people would do whatever was required to correct this injustice. It wouldn't matter that you were heavily involved in many charities, or looking after your grandchildren, or overwhelmed with job responsibilities, or that you were in frail health - none of this would prevent you from doing the right thing.

Fast forward to some hospitals in this city where pregnant girls sit in waiting rooms, and one by one are ushered into the operating room with its special tables and lights and with doctors and nurses appropriately clad, including surgical masks and gloves. Sounds respectable, doesn't it? Then the "procedure" takes place... some refer to it as choice. After the living pre-borns are removed (read "torn apart"), the tiny bodies are examined and the remains go to medical waste. Different process but eerily similar to the death camps of bygone years.

How does our community respond? The vast majority don't react as they would with the abuse story above. That's the problem! I think the largest number don't really think about abortion... they are busy getting on with their lives.

So what's the answer? Our organization's mandate is education. That means it's our job to educate the public about the sanctity of life issues including keeping abortion front and centre so that this community will never again be able to say "I didn't know."

So how does this involve you? Frankly, I ask you to consider contributing more of your time, talent and/or treasure... all of these are essential for our operation.

The London Area Right to Life consists of a part-time co-ordinator and volunteers. A few of us spend a substantial amount of our waking hours dedicated to this cause. We need the same response you would give if abuse were taking place next door... and it is. The culture of death is relentless and our response (notice I said *our* response) must also be relentless. **Please, think about what you have been able to do this last year to defend life and then ask yourself could I do more to help in this essential struggle. (see the appeal letter on page 3) Consider taping the enclosed prayer card somewhere prominent and pray daily that our Creator will send more labourers into His vineyard, strengthen our resolve and help those on the front lines to persevere.**



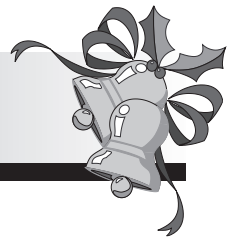

First let me put things in focus. The 'Ways of Death' that we use in our 7/8 pro-life presentations does a pretty good job of comparing tragedies. Even cancer in Canada which is approximately 70,000 deaths each year (a disease which we spend millions to eradicate) pales when compared with the 107,000 of our own children sacrificed under the heading of CHOICE. Unbelievable! Our job is to stand on the side of life and witness and inform others of this holocaust. I guarantee you that without your support we would cease to exist.

Our office has supplied information to hundreds in this community and has proven particularly popular with students searching for resource material. Our presence at Fanshawe College's 'Sexual Awareness Week', 10 days at the Western Fair booth, the Ilderton Fair and a pro-life display at Argyle Mall got our presence into the public square.

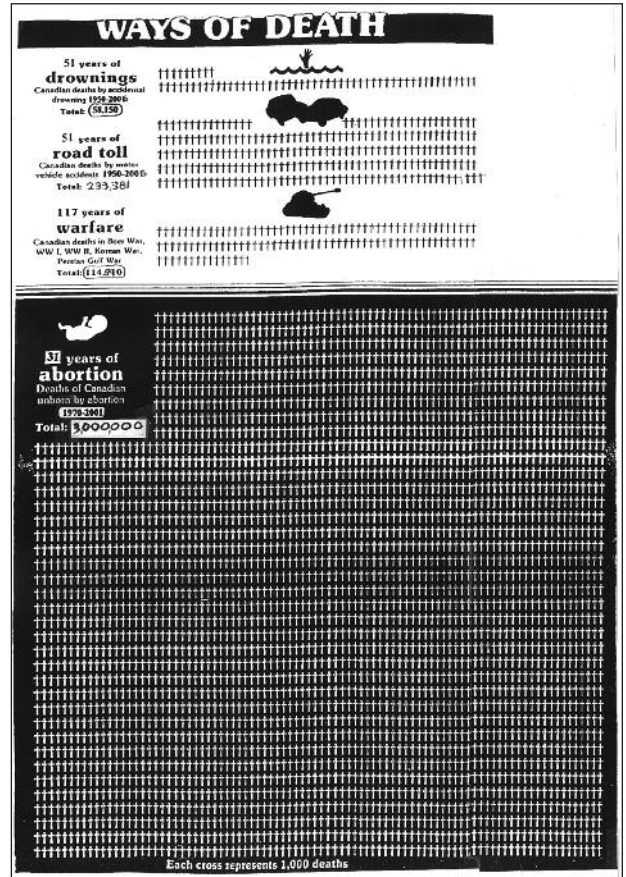
The elementary school presentations, over 200 in two years, touch 5,500 grades 5/6 and 7/8 students. We hand out almost 36,000 pieces of information (pamphlets, etc.) to the students and staff. In partnership with the Catholic School Board we arranged for a chastity speaker to present at eight secondary schools consisting of 8,800 students and 700 staff. Total cost - \$10,000.

We work with and financially support the pro-life students' clubs at Western and Kings College. We advertise on billboards, in newspapers, and the backlit boards and the student handbook at Fanshawe. We hope to upgrade our website this year. In addition we provided class sets of Lovematters.com chastity newspapers, DVD's and pro-life binders to the secondary schools. Total cost - \$16,000.

It is due solely to the many volunteers and your generosity that we have been able to accomplish these endeavours. I sign this letter 'Beggars for Christ' because that's how I see myself. We and all the Right to Life Members are His hands and His feet for life. We are really the chosen few called to speak for the little ones. Join us in being their voice, hear their cries... Please be generous.

Good News Story!

PRO-LIFE CONVERSION - LifeSiteNews.com Thursday, Nov. 13, 2008

The Spanish daily "La Razon" has published an article about the pro-life conversion of a former "champion of abortion." **Stojan Adasevic, spent 26 years as the most renowned abortion doctor in Serbia, performing 48,000 abortions – between 20 and 30 a day. Now he is the most important pro-life leader in the country**

In the early years, as a medical student, Adasevic remembers one day organizing files in the corner of a doctor's room. He overheard some gynaecologists swapping stories about their medical practice. One of the doctors recalled a patient who had come to him for an abortion. The procedure failed and the doctor continued to discuss the woman's history and Stojan suddenly realized the woman was his mother. "She's dead now" observed the doctor, "but I wonder what happened to the unwanted child?" Stojan couldn't resist. "I'm the child" he said. Silently the doctors left the room. It was perfectly clear to Stojan: he owed his life to the failed abortion.

Belgrade. But after years of doing abortions Adasevic began to have nightmares.

In describing his conversion, Adasevic said he dreamed about a beautiful field full of children and young people from 4 to 24 years of age who were playing and laughing, but who ran away from him in fear. A man dressed in a black and white

habit stared at him in silence. The dream was repeated each night and he would wake up in a cold sweat. One night he asked the man in black and white who he was. 'My name is Thomas Aquinas,' the man in his dream responded. Adasevic, educated in communist schools, had never heard of the Dominican genius saint. He didn't recognize the name.

St. Thomas told Adasevic that the children he saw are the ones he killed with his abortions. Adasevic awoke in amazement and decided not to perform any more abortions.

But that same day a cousin came to the hospital with his four months-pregnant girlfriend, who wanted to get her ninth abortion - something quite frequent in the countries of the Soviet bloc. The doctor agreed. Instead of removing the fetus piece by piece, he decided to chop it up and remove it as a mass. However, the baby's heart came out still beating. Adasevic realized then that he had killed a human being.

After this experience, Adasevic told the hospital he would no longer perform abortions. Never before had a doctor in Communist Yugoslavia refused to do so. They cut his salary in half, fired his daughter from her job, and did not allow his son to enter the university.

After years of pressure and on the verge of giving up, he had another dream about St. Thomas.

"You are my good friend, keep going," the man in black and white told him. Adasevic became involved in the pro-life movement and was able to get Yugoslav television to air the film 'The Silent Scream,' by Doctor Bernard Nathanson, two times. Adasevic has told his story in magazines and newspapers throughout Eastern Europe and has returned to the Orthodox faith of his childhood. Scientific advancements since Thomas' time have revealed that human life begins at the moment of conception. Today Dr. Adasevic continues to fight for the lives of the unborn.

36 YEARS at the WESTERN FAIR

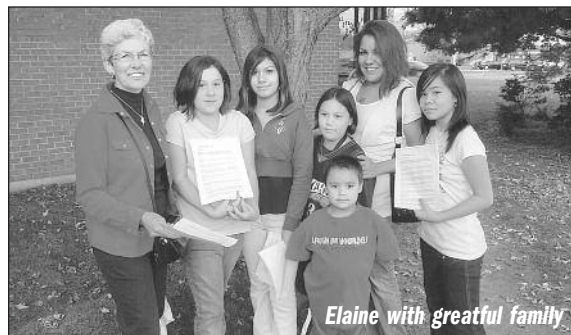


Thank you, thank you! We love you! *by Elaine Arnsby*

In September I read that the London Middlesex Health Unit would be going to three London public libraries on Sept. 18, 24, and 25. Their mission was to promote Gardasil, the controversial HPV vaccine administered to prevent cervical cancer. On their web site the only side effects listed are "pain and redness or swelling where the needle was given, and fainting after vaccination also occasionally occurs".

I gathered the latest statistics on the adverse side effects of Gardasil. There were 10,000 adverse events including severe headaches, dizziness, temporary loss of vision, slurred speech, fainting (seizures), joint pain, muscle weakness, involuntary contraction of the limbs, genital warts, anaphylactic shock, grand mal convulsion, foaming at the mouth, coma, paralysis and 21 deaths (as of August 2008).

I also found information on how Merck-Frosst Pharmaceuticals which had developed the vaccine had done very little research on the long term effects (on fertility and genetic changes), and whether it is effective on young girls. The long term effectiveness of the vaccine is 5 years according to The Health Unit. The average age of women with cervical cancer is 47... Meanwhile, Merck stands to gain millions of dollars.



Cervical cancer can be prevented by regular Pap smears without endangering our young girls lives.

And so, armed with our print-outs, Phil, Margarida Andre, her son and I stood outside and spoke with each mother going into the Beacock library on the first night. Some had their daughters with them. **All were eager to accept our literature and, upon hearing and reading the lack of testing and possible effects of the vaccine, every one of them turned around and left. The girls from one family were so happy they were cheering and telling us, "Thank you, thank you, we love you!" We found out that the Health Unit was actually giving the vaccine that night.** The reception from the public at the other two libraries, Pond Mills and Jalna, was the same - they refused to put their daughters in jeopardy. We were very glad and thankful about the responses to our efforts.

NATURAL HELP for INFERTILITY

Researchers from the International Institute of Restorative Reproductive Medicine in Ireland have published a study in the Journal of the American Board of Family Medicine which confirms that natural procreative technology, called **NaProTechnology or NPT (trade mark - FertilityCare) - a non-invasive fertility-care based medical approach to the treatment of infertility - provided live birth rates comparable or superior to more invasive treatments, including Assisted Reproductive Technology (ART) and In Vitro Fertilization (IVF).**

The study 1072 couples who had sought medical help because of difficulty conceiving or carrying a pregnancy to term.

Nearly half the patients had been told they have unexplained infertility. After NPT investigations, $\frac{2}{3}$ of the patients had a hormone abnormality and more than $\frac{1}{4}$ were diagnosed with cervical mucus dysfunction, a critical factor for sperm survival and transport. Once these and other problems were identified and treated, NPT enabled the couples to conceive using a natural act of intercourse.

Overall, 52.8% of patients completing treatment could expect to have a successful live birth, which rivals previously published results for expensive In Vitro Fertilization, which may require patients to endure multiple invasive treatments to achieve a similar success rate. One third of these patients had already failed IVF, were older and had tried longer to have a baby. For patients who hadn't tried IVF, the live birth rate rose to 61.5%.

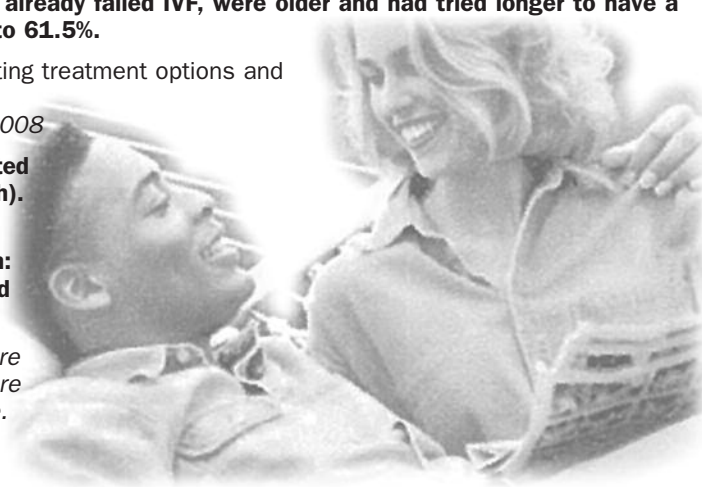

University Threatens Pro-life Club!

Nov. 26/27, the University of Calgary threatened Campus Pro-Life with suspension, expulsion, and even arrest. The club was presenting the Genocide Awareness Project (GAP) on campus for the fifth time since 2006 but now the university insisted they "turn the display inward" so that it could not be seen by passers-by.



At the same time, other activists on campus displayed large, graphic photographs of torture perpetrated by the Chinese government on adherents of Falun Gong. Campus Security did not serve these protesters the "Notice" indicating they would have to turn their images inwards or also risk arrest. Leah Hallman, president of Campus Pro-Life, called this a double standard, stating, "Those protesting the mistreatment of Falun Gong practitioners are correctly allowed their right to free expression, but why aren't we?"

We of Campus Pro-Life can accept no compromise with the evil of abortion. The value of lives saved is far beyond the value of anything we could lose by our stand. Arrest us, charge us, expel us, do what you want with these bodies of ours! But for every Pro-Lifer who suffers for the cause, perhaps, just perhaps, another life will be born into this world. And so it is with that hope that we are willing to risk all that we are putting on the line today. We shall let history be the judge of our actions."

The Christmas Truce by David G. Stratman

It was December 25, 1914 only 5 months into World War 1. German, British, and French soldiers, already sick and tired of the senseless killing, disobeyed their superiors and fraternized with the enemy along two-thirds of the Western Front (a crime punishable by death in times of war). German troops held Christmas trees up out of the trenches with, Merry Christmas."

"You no shoot, we no shoot." Thousands of troops streamed across a no-man's land strewn with rotting corpses. They sang Christmas carols, exchanged photographs of loved ones back home, shared rations, played football, even roasted some pigs. **Soldiers embraced men they had been trying to kill a few short hours before. They agreed to warn each other if the top brass forced them to fire their weapons, and to aim high.**

A shudder ran through the high command on either side. Here was disaster in the making: soldiers declaring their brotherhood with each other and refusing to fight. Generals on both sides declared this spontaneous peacemaking to be treasonous and subject to court martial. By March 1915 the fraternization movement had been eradicated and the killing machine put back in full operation. By the time of the armistice in 1918, fifteen million would be slaughtered.

The following song is based on a true story from the front lines of World War 1 that I've heard many times. Ian Calhoun, a Scot, was the commanding officer of the British forces involved in the story. He was subsequently court-martialed for 'consorting with the enemy' and sentenced to death. Only George V spared him from that fate.

Two years ago the war was waiting for me after school.
To Belgium and to Flanders, to Germany to here,
I fought for King and country I love dear.

'Twas Christmas in the trenches, where the frost so bitter hung.

Their brave and glorious lads so far away.

As soon as they were finished and a reverent pause was spent, "God Rest Ye Merry, Gentlemen" struck up some lads from Kent. The next they sang was "Stille Nacht," "'Tis 'Silent Night!'", says I, And in two tongues one song filled up that sky.

"There's someone coming towards us!" the front line sentry cried. All sights were fixed on one lone figure trudging from their side. His truce flag, like a Christmas star, shone on that plain so bright, As he, bravely, strode unarmed into the night.

Soon one by one on either side walked into No Man's Land, With neither gun no bayonet we met there hand to hand. We shared some secret brandy and wished each other well, And in a flare lit soccer game we gave 'em hell.

We traded chocolates, cigarettes, and photographs from home. These sons and fathers far away from families of their own. Young Sanders played his squeezebox and they had a violin, This curious and unlikely band of men.

Soon daylight stole upon us and France was France once more. With sad farewells we each prepared to settle back to war. But the question haunted every heart that lived that wondrous night: "Whose family have I fixed within my sights?"

'Twas Christmas in the trenches where the frost, so bitter hung. The frozen fields of France were warmed as songs of peace were sung. For the walls they'd kept between us to exact the work of war, Had been crumbled and were gone forevermore.

My name is Francis Toliver, in Liverpool I dwell, Each Christmas come since World War 1, I've learned its lessons well, That the ones who call the shots won't be among the dead and lame, And on each end of the rifle we're the same.

ADULT STEM CELL THERAPY CURES AIDS

The startling case of an Aids patient who was cured after undergoing a bone marrow transplant to treat leukemia is stirring new hope that researchers might someday find a cure for Aids.

The patient, a 42 year old American living in Berlin, is still recovering from his leukemia therapy, but appears to have won his battle with Aids. Doctors have not been able to detect the virus in his blood for more than 600 days despite his having ceased all conventional Aids medication. Normally when a patient stops taking Aids drugs, the virus stampedes through the body within weeks, or days.

The breakthrough appears to be that Dr. Hutter, a soft spoken haematologist who isn't an Aids specialist, deliberately replaced the patient's bone marrow cells with those from a donor who has a naturally occurring genetic mutation that renders his cells immune to almost all strains of HIV, the virus that causes Aids.
