# Mary Wagner's Right to Take a Stand on Behalf of Unborn Children Takes Centre Stage at Trial

Mary Wagner's case is a **mirror image of Henry Morgentaler's** moves to break the law and then challenge the legality of Canada's then-in-force laws restricting abortion.

That was defense counsel Charles Lugosi's argument before Justice Fergus O'Donnell as Wagner's long-running trial on charges of mischief and failing to comply with probation orders continued in the Ont. Court of Justice Tuesday. Mary argues she was justified in her action of entering the "Women's Care Clinic" abortion centre on Lawrence Ave. W. in Toronto on Aug. 12, 2012. Section 37 of the Criminal Code states a person has the right to "trespass" in order to prevent injury or death to anyone in danger. Wagner contends the word "anyone" in this provision must include the unborn.

Lugosi added that, even though Section 223 of the Criminal Code, the "born alive" section, states an unborn child is not a person, that does not mean it is not a human being. "If it's a human being one minute after it's born, it's also a human being one minute before it's born. ... Fetuses are a class excluded from the human family," he said. "I'm asking for Mary's day in court. ... This is not a philosophical exercise or a moral lecture, but rather the application of law at its heart. ... Is there a more fundamental question than who is and who is not a member of the human family?"

It is a disgrace that in modern society, a class of human beings continues to be excluded from enjoying legal protection, said Lugosi.

In her rebuttal, Vogel, the Crown in Wagner's case, vociferously argued there is not one case in any Canadian legal jurisdiction wherein a fetus was granted personhood status. Granting Wagner's request would "bust open" access for "anti-abortion activists" to "invade private property and criminalize abortion," she continued. "This would grant standing to any legal contortionist with deeply held convictions."

The self-defence provision to which Wagner is appealing does not apply in her context, she said, because Mary did not use force...

The Crown attorney said Wagner's challenge ignores the "tradition" in Canadian law of refusing personhood for the fetus; this was made most clear in cases such as Demers, Borowski and Winnipeg vs. Child Family Services. The Supreme Court has said through it all that the only rights to be recognized in any aspect of law – tort, civil, criminal or common – are those of a born person. "Changes are up to Parliament to make", Vogel said.

In response, Lugosi emphasized again that Wagner is doing nothing different from what Henry Morgentaler did. "Has the Supreme Court dealt with it? No. ... In Demers, the court did not consider properly made arguments ... (and) the Charter (of Rights) was not considered in the Tremblay case. That was a totally civil matter concerning Quebec law." The courts have explicitly pointed out their rulings have not been conclusive, said Lugosi.

O'Donnell put off his decision on the constitutional standing argument to February 28 at 2 p.m. in Room 308 of the Ontario Court of Justice at 1000 Finch Avenue West in Toronto. Wagner will remain in custody until that time, as she has since her arrest on Aug. 12, 2012, as she declines to sign bail conditions that stipulate she stay away from abortion sites.

The public gallery was filled for the hearing as is the hope for Feb. 28. Among those watching was Linda Gibbons, who is awaiting hearings on appeals regarding three previous convictions she was given for quietly demonstrating outside Toronto abortion sites in recent years.

# Abortion Drug RU-486

## SCIENTIFIC REVIEW IN CANADA:

Health Canada says that its scientists are currently conducting a “scientific review” of the abortion drug, RU-486. It stated that if it meets the “requirements of the regulations, an authorization may be issued. All new drug applications are required to meet evidentiary standards demonstrating safety, effectiveness, and quality, including that the benefits outweigh any risks.”

## HOW RU-486 WORKS:

An RU-486 abortion involves a two-drug combination, usually offered to women less than nine weeks pregnant. Mifepristone, a synthetic steroid, blocks the hormone progesterone. This shuts down the woman’s pregnancy-sustaining mechanism with the result that the baby, deprived of necessary life-support, starves to death, and detaches from the uterine wall. Misoprostol, given a day or so later, initiates powerful uterine contractions that cause the woman to expel her dead baby.



## HISTORY:

\*RU-486 was developed in 1986 by French pharmaceutical company, Roussel Uclaf, a subsidiary of the same company which produced the Zyklon-B gas for use in Nazi gas chambers during WWII.

\*A PREVIOUS Canadian trial of RU-486 was shelved in 2001 after the death of a woman from toxic shock, brought on by a bacterial infection related to the chemical abortion of her child.

\*A 2011 U.S. Food and Drug Administration report found that 14 U.S. women died after taking RU-486. Of the 2207 adverse events listed, 612 women were hospitalized, 339 experienced blood loss that required transfusions, 256 had infections, pelvic inflammatory disease, endometriosis, pelvic infections with sepsis, with 48 being severe, hospitalized for 2-3 days. 58 women had ectopic pregnancies, the RU-486 regimen is contraindicated for women with ectopic pregnancies! Several of the women (7 of 14) who died in the U.S., “died from sepsis (severe illness caused by infection of the bloodstream) after medical abortion with mifepristone and misoprostol...Sepsis is a known risk related to any type of abortion”.

## WARNINGS:

- Jakki Jeffs, Executive Director of Alliance for Life Ontario, writes: RU-486 is a drug which has been specifically designed to starve a child, followed by the administration of another drug, Cytotec, to induce labour and expel the dead or dying child. Four visits at minimum to the facility then the wait for your chemical miscarriage, at home alone, work or play – plus another internal examination and by the way bring what’s left of the child with you. Doesn’t this all sound very liberating?
- The Canadian Physicians for Life urged Health Canada in a strongly worded statement to say ‘no’ to the drug because of the trail of suffering and death it has left behind in the countries where it is permitted. “This is death we talking about, not just of the unborn babies but sometimes of the mothers themselves,” stated the pro-life doctors’ group.
- Campaign Life Coalition (CLC), calling RU-486 a “human pesticide” that harms mothers and kills babies, has launched an online petition to keep the drug out of Canada that will be submitted to the country’s health minister Rona Ambrose.

## Canadian Pro-Life Youth Delegation At Washington D.C. MARCH for LIFE

On Wednesday, January 22nd, America marked 41 years since Roe v. Wade. A truly nation-defining decision, it opened the floodgates to an atrocity so mind bogglingly grave that it seems trite to even call it the greatest human rights abuse in U.S. history. **The murder of over 56 million of its own children, over a sixth of America's citizens, is not a mere "abuse". Genocide doesn't even cover it.**

Campaign Life Coalition, organizers of Canada's own March for Life, which takes place on May 8th, sent a youth delegation, 15-strong, to attend the DC March on Jan. 22.

**One day prior to the March, Alissa Golob, head of Campaign Coalition Youth, spoke at the Law of Life Summit, one of the official March for Life activities, where she joined over 30 U.S. pro-life leaders.**

"Since abortion was decriminalized in 1969, we've had 45 different pieces of legislation that have been put forward by Canadian MPs throughout the years attempting to pass some sort of law on abortion, and not one has passed," Alissa Golob told participants at the March in Washington D. C.

At the Vigil Mass at the Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception on the night before the March, 10,000 participants 33 bishops, 300 priests, 60 deacons, and 550 seminarians participated. The team was delighted to see Toronto Cardinal Thomas Collins con-celebrate the Mass.

The Canadian team obtained a permit to hold their banners, signs, and a large Canadian flag along the route of the March, right in front of the Canadian Embassy. "We were chanting and yelling that we support [the pro-life marchers] and they were running over to us giving us high-fives and taking pictures with us and thanking us for supporting them," Golob said.



Golob said that at the end of the day, abortion is an issue that affects everyone, "regardless of country or border". "Children all around the world are being killed at the hands of abortionists. All of us, from every country must stand together and demand an end to the killing," she said.

# Tremendous Court Victory for Life!

The Euthanasia Prevention Coalition (EPC) won a tremendous victory on Feb. 3 in the Bentley case. The Bentley case sought to define oral feeding as health care in order to withdraw feeding from Margaret Bentley. EPC intervened in the Bentley case. We argued that oral feeding does not constitute health care, but rather basic care and withdrawing it constituted neglect under the law.



**The BC court agreed that oral feeding does not constitute health care but rather basic personal care and not medical treatment and the withdrawal of oral hydration and nutri-**

**tion for an adult that is not capable of consenting constitutes neglect under the law – Section 215 of the Criminal Code which concerns the Duty of persons to provide the necessities of life.**

## GATES / USAID CONTRACEPTION PLAN EXPOSED

### DEPO PROVERA:

Numerous studies have linked the controversial drug, Depo Provera, with bone loss (osteoporosis), increased risk of blood clots, breast cancer, cervical cancer, increased herpes susceptibility, heart disease, memory loss, and, by compromising a woman's immune system, increases the risk of infection from STDs, and contributes to the spread of HIV/AIDS.

The US Agency of International Development (USAID) and the Gates Foundation have spent millions of dollars to increase injectable contraceptive use among women in high-HIV communities in sub-Saharan Africa. Melinda Gates launched a \$4 billion partnership which includes funding to produce and deliver the injectable Depo Provera.



### DECEPTION:

In Geneva, the World Health Organization, USAID, CDC, and Gates officials attempted to conceal the harmful contraceptive. **According to the tiny NGO The Rebecca Project the use of Depo Provera is driven by profit at any cost and a 'population control' ideological agenda.** Despite attempts to conceal the harmful side effects, more poor women are abandoning use of Depo Provera due to associated side effects and health concerns. Fr. Boquet of Human Life International has stated, "It is low income and minority women who suffer most from Depo Provera and that suffering extends to families and communities which often are already lacking quality health care."

### EXPOSURE:

The Rebecca Project, which is actually pro-contraception, has exposed the documents on their website calling it "an egregious...human tragedy".

**According to the Wall Street Journal's Market Watch, the drug's manufacturer, Pfizer, is estimated to earn \$36 billion in annual sales. The Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation (BMGF) donated \$560 million and various European and African governments committed to raising \$2.6 billion to administer contraception, specifically Depo Provera, to women in the developing world.**

### HOPE:

The exposure means the issue of Depo Provera's harm now has to be decided in a court of law where a judge will review scientific and social research data. Considering the overwhelming evidence of Depo Provera's harm Health Ministers in targeted developing countries must be encouraged to restrict or ban Depo Provera as a family planning option. This is exactly what Israel did in 2013 to protect women and, in Ghana, human rights expert Dr. Charlotte Abaka, the former Chair of the UN women's treaty committee, now advocates ending or restricting Depo Provera.

# Jailed pro-life activist in open letter: I am 'blessed' to share in the sufferings of Christ

Editor's note: Mary Wagner has spent 2.6 years in prison since March of 2010 for peacefully entering Toronto abortion clinics, where she offers abortion-bound women a rose, and pro-life counseling.



This letter goes out from Vanier CW, an Ontario jail where I have been incarcerated for the last 14 months. I am awaiting trial on charges of "mischief: interference with lawful enjoyment/operation of a business," and breach of a probation order that unjustly prohibits me from entering within 200 m. of any place where abortions are committed in Ontario.

Several people from Canada and abroad have asked if I would write something to help convey why I am here. I hope the following will be of help to my Christian brothers and sisters in particular, as well as to anyone of good will, especially those who care about the littlest and most defenceless of God's children, our brothers and sisters in the womb.

I am a Catholic and having been raised in a large and very pro-life family, was active in what many would consider various branches in the pro-life movement. As a young adult, God attracted me more and more, and seeking His will became more important. Through prayer and discernment, He showed me more deeply the painful reality of abortion, and I realized that He was leading me to go to these places where His little ones are killed, to pray, to speak to the mothers and for their little ones; to be present and not to walk away, but to remain with them, regardless of the outcome. Each person, no matter how small, is a unique, unrepeatable human being of infinite worth, made in God's image and likeness, precious to Him and deserving of our love, as Jesus Himself tells us: "whatsoever you do to the least of these, my brothers and sisters, you do to me" (Mt. 25:40)

As Canadians are aware, abortion was decriminalized in this country over forty years ago. This has resulted in the killing of millions of unborn children at all stages of pregnancy (to say nothing of the many who are also irreparably harmed in the womb because of their mother's alcohol and drug abuse). Until one is born, there is no legal protection from the abuse or killing, since in law, there is no personhood status recognized.

With time, abortion has gained acceptance as the "providing of a medical procedure", and those who seek to intervene on behalf of the babies in imminent danger can be - and are - charged with crimes, as I am, as Linda Gibbons has been repeatedly, and as many others in the past have been as well.

It is vital that we realize that abortion is NOT a medical procedure, but the killing of helpless children. When a human being is threatened with death, it is a gravely unjust law that would prevent people from protecting him or her. Catholic teaching makes this clear in Section 2242 of the Catechism of the Catholic Church:

The citizen is obliged in conscience not to follow the directives of civil authorities when they are contrary to the demands of the moral order, to the fundamental rights of persons or the teachings of the Gospel. Refusing obedience to civil authorities, when their demands are contrary to an upright conscience, finds its distinction between serving God and serving the political community. "We must obey God rather than men" (Acts 5:29)

Mother Teresa condensed the message of Mt 25:40 into what she called "the five finger Gospel": "You did it to me".

As Mother knew so deeply, Jesus "thirsts for love, especially in the poorest and most forgotten. Who, in our cities and towns, are more forgotten, unloved, than the child - indeed the mother and child - entering the abortion clinic"?

I have been arrested numerous times as a result of reaching out to mothers within the "Bubble Zone" and for remaining on the property where abortions are committed. In such cases, my presence is deemed "interference with...a business", the "business" being abortion. Of the many times I have been present to the abortion-minded mothers, there have been some mothers who had a change of heart and left before it was too late for their children. Sadly, many have gone through with the abortion. However, even if the child is not spared, the outcome does not change the truth that Jesus, present in "the least of these," was shown some love; He was not utterly abandoned in death. If we are arrested, we can truly say, in faith, that we are blessed to share in some small way in the suffering He endured so willingly for each one of us.

My lawyer, Dr. Charles Lugosi, has been working hard to prepare my defence that will bring the unborn child into the centre focus and will also concern the implications of the fact that our constitution was founded on the supremacy of God. Please pray for this case and for the parties involved. Prayer is of utmost importance. As Jesus said "Without me, you can do nothing" (Jn15:5)

Please pray for me and the other women here at Vanier, many of whom are post-abortive and in need of healing, and for those who, while pregnant here, are able to be taken to have abortions. Let us recall the words of Mother Teresa:
