Dire Predictions for this Planet!

- *President's message by Phil Arnsby*

Unless you have been on a deserted island somewhere, you would have noticed the shrill calls to action to save our world from the environmental disasters to come. Calls to set emission caps, to participate in emissions trading systems and to comply with intensity targets abound. Recommendations to enforce using non-incandescent light bulbs and even suggestions to reduce the amount of toilet paper we use (to save the forests) are being made.



Lorne Gunter (lgunter@shaw.ca) of the National Post wrote this: *Think of the atmosphere as 100 cases of 24 one-litre bottles of water - 2,400 litres in all. According to the global warming theory, rising levels of human-produced carbon dioxide are trapping more of the sun's reflected heat in the atmosphere and dangerously warming the planet. But 99 of our cases would be nitrogen (78%) and oxygen (21%), neither of which are greenhouse gases. Only one case - just 24 bottles out of 2,400 - would contain greenhouse gases. Of the bottles in the greenhouse gas case 23 would be water vapour of which we have little control. The very last bottle of the 2,400 bottles would be carbon dioxide - and just .04% of the entire atmosphere - In that last bottle at least 95% is naturally occurring carbon dioxide (decaying plants, forest fires, volcanoes, etc.) At most, 5% of the carbon dioxide in the air comes from human sources (one shot glass worth). Canada's share is only 2% of that 'shot glass'.*

So what's my point?

I hope that all of us would act appropriately concerning the environment and do everything possible to save from destruction this planet we live on.

However, the goal for our organization is to save from destruction the innocents purposely being slaughtered in our hospitals and abortion 'clinics'.

This disregard for human life must trump all other priorities. The leader of the Green party was at a church in London recently and delivered a moving sermon. She said "We have a moral obligation to our Lord and Father to ensure we don't destroy the creation that was given to us.

Although she was referring to the environment, the words most appropriately apply to saving human life.

It is tragically bizarre that the four major Canadian political parties are into the environmental frenzy while ignoring the most destructive environmental issue of the 21st century - the destruction of the human race through abortion!



Courage! There is great hope. We are slowly but surely making a difference. In the United States, many states are passing pro-life legislation and just recently, partial birth abortions were banned. GOOD NEWS REPORT

Drop in U.S. Teen Sexual Activity Rates Linked to Abstinence Programs, Says Top Researcher *LifeSite News May 2, 2007*

According to reports by official government statistics, teen sexual activity has decreased dramatically between 1991 and 2005 in the U.S. and the drop is being linked to the growing use of abstinence programs in schools.

Teen pregnancy rates have also dropped markedly since peaking in 1994. According to the National Vital Statistics Report, the unwed birthrate for teens age 15 - 19 years has dropped by 25% since 1994. Reduction in pregnancy rates parallels a dramatic reduction in teen abortion rates - the numbers halved since 1988, according to the National Center for Health Statistics.

Janice Shaw Crouse, Senior Fellow at the Beverly LaHaye Institute, in a Townhall.com column says **the increase in abstinence programs over the past decade parallels the decrease in sexual activity.** While the media routinely condemn abstinence programs as ineffective, the legacy of "safe sex" education is an explosion in teen pregnancy rates and sexually transmitted infections.

Crouse points out, "These simultaneous reverses in trends indicate that teens are choosing a path that is proven to lead to a bright and promising future both in their personal lives and in every other aspect of their well-being."

NOTE: *The above stats are just so great! It underlines the need to continue our school programmes of abstinence and informed choices.*

Calling All Priests and Pastors - LifeSite News, April 26, 2007

Fr. Frank Pavone, National Director of Priests for Life, applauded the remarks made Monday by Vatican Archbishop Angelo Amato, secretary of the Congregation for the Doctrine of the Faith. The Archbishop called abortion "terrorism with a human face." He said, "Besides the abominable terrorism of suicide bombers, which is ever-present in the media, there is the so-called **terrorism with a human face**, which is also a daily occurrence and just as repugnant, which continues to be propagated by the media, manipulating traditional language with expressions that hide the tragic reality of the facts."

"Our organization challenges every priest and pastor in America to repeat these words from the pulpit," said Fr. Pavone. "Even preachers of the Gospel can be in denial about abortion and may think that sugar-coated words will solve the problem. They won't. It's time to strengthen our language and bring it into line with the reality of what abortion is."

6000 Students Mesmerized by Doug Herman

Have you ever been in a high school gymnasium with 1100 secondary school students and experienced the entire assembly totally attentive for a full hour? Who said "in your dreams"... I was there I can verify for the 'Doubting Thomas'.

Doug Herman is definitely fabulous. He uses a unique blend of humour that had the students clapping and laughing and at other times there was hardly a dry eye in the place.

Some students put on their head phones on the way from class to the gym. Doug made them a deal - take the ear phones out for 20 minutes and if after that time they were bored then they had permission to put them back in. No one did!

Doug has spoken to over 3000 school assemblies. He is one of North America's premier speakers on chastity, sexual choices, and the risks involved. He took the students through his life story, one that was heart rendering...

His wife, Evon, was a beautiful girl he met in high school. Doug said he lived in Nebraska on a pig farm - "people could smell him coming" (at several assemblies, students cheered, apparently they had similar backgrounds). Eventually, Evon gave birth to a lovely baby boy (after Doug fainted twice) and after about 18 months she was again pregnant and looking forward to their second child. The hospital called and asked Evon to come in for some tests. They didn't say why. Two weeks later the family was called in - Evon had received some HIV tainted blood just after their son's birth. They were dumbfounded - both had been faithful - they didn't even live in Los Angeles! - it was so unfair. Doug and his son were continually tested - negative. But when Evon gave birth to her daughter Ashley the baby was an AIDS baby. As Doug recounted in detail how his wife and his daughter both died you could hear a pin drop.

Doug used his story as a springboard into the fact that his family had no choice in what happened, BUT, all the students have a choice. He used humour and powerful images of what the students are facing, encouraging them to set their standard high. He finished by using an example of a weight lifter lying on his back pressing weights - with someone who cares for him spotting and assisting with the weights to prevent injury. As **Doug illustrated resisting pressure over and over again, he asked the audience what happens - they shouted, "YOU GET STRONGER!" Right! As you resist pressure repeatedly you get stronger and will be less likely to give in to 'going with the crowd'. Amen!**

Breaking News - Important Read - by *Phil Arnsby*

WHEN ARE WE GOING TO LEARN?

Years ago 'the pill' was going to liberate women, improve family relationships and abortion would be reduced if not eliminated. Did it work? You know the answer.

Then the condom and other devices would prevent, if not eliminate, STD's and certainly reduce abortion to a distant memory - users would now be free without worrying about the consequences.

DID IT WORK?? - Sexually transmitted diseases are now rampant and millions are dying.

You may recall last month's newsletter - in 1991 **Thailand promoted condoms** (population 62,833,000) and the **Philippines promoted chastity** (population 70,999,000). In 2003 the deaths from AIDS: Thailand - 58,000, Philippines - 500. **WHAT DON'T WE GET?** Now, an HPV vaccine, Gardasil...it flies in the face of all chastity programmes as use of this vaccine pre-supposes premarital sex.

GARDASIL

Gardasil is a three-dose vaccine produced by the drug conglomerate Merck & Co. released last June for young girls and women ages 9 to 26 protecting against HPV 16 and HPV 18 strains that cause 70% of cervical, vulvar and vaginal cancers and genital warts. HPV is a sexually transmitted disease that can be spread through skin to skin contact anywhere in the genital area.

Canada's federal government 2007-2008 budget, announced on March 20 by the Harper Conservatives, includes \$300 million to be distributed to the individual provinces to fund the new HPV vaccination. However, many are concerned that politicians may be recommending the drug without giving sufficient thought to the potential side-effects or benefits of Gardasil in young girls.

In the U.S., Wendy Wright, President of Concerned Women for America, documents that Merck sacrificed adequate data testing involving pre-adolescent children (its target group). **Merck utilized adult data to "predict" the immune response in children, meaning it has no evidence the vaccine prevents anything when given to**



children ages 9 - 12. Also, the maximum median follow-up in any of its studies was 4 years, while sexually-transmitted HPV requires 10-15 years from time of infection to the development of cervical cancer. The Washington Times reports Merck's target age for girls' to receive the vaccine is too low: Girls inoculated with Gardasil will be no older than 18 when they reach the end of the vaccine's 5 year hoped-for effectiveness. Given the current assumption that the vaccine may be 10 years effective, it still leaves them vulnerable in their 20s to early 30s, while the typical cervical cancer patient (age 47) acquires the virus in her 30s.

Another problem: the National Vaccination Information Center president, Barbara Loe Fisher said, "Nobody at Merck, the CDC or FDA know if the injection of Gardasil into all pre-teen girls - especially simultaneously with hepatitis B vaccine - will make some of them more likely to develop arthritis or other inflammatory autoimmune and brain disorders as teenagers and adults." There are growing reports in the States of **mild to severe adverse effects involving Gardasil including severe headaches, dizziness, temporary loss of vision, some lost consciousness during what appear to be seizures, and temporary paralysis.** Fisher said, "There are twice as many children collapsing and four times as many children experiencing tingling, numbness and loss of sensation after getting a Gardasil vaccination compared to those getting a Tdap (tetanus-diphtheria-acellular pertussis) vaccination. There have been reports of facial paralysis and Guillain-Barre Syndrome."

Despite media efforts in Canada to portray the vaccination as 100% backed by the entire medical community, Merck has since had to cease its massive lobbying campaign. There has been substantial resistance from many different parties including concerned parent and prominent figures and groups in the medical community. **While Merck rakes in millions of dollars, our young girls would be used as guinea pigs. PRAY!**

"Show the Truth and Children"

Excerpt from an article by Amy Gordon in *Catholic Insight* (Nov. 2006)

Background: *When Amy was 11 years old she saw her first "Show The Truth" display. She had vaguely been aware of the evil of abortion from an early age, but somehow abortion did not seem real to her because the media showed other evils and nothing on abortion. As a result of seeing an actual photo of an aborted child, she has become a pro-life missionary.*

"One may not doubt the power of images to make people aware of abortion, but may ask the legitimate question as to whether it is advisable to show the photographs where there is a possibility of children seeing them (this, in short, is anywhere). Over the years, I have been careful to observe the reactions of children at Show The Truth displays. I noticed that often younger children do not pay attention to the photographs but are engaged in doing what little children do - talking and skipping around, etc. Older or more observant children are composed, curious, and frequently saddened, and they respond to the pictures by asking questions of their parents. This is an excellent opportunity for parents to teach their children in a loving way about this important issue. Often children and parents have thanked us for our presence; some have even taken pictures of the display, or asked to help our work in some way.

I also observed the responses of my own younger siblings when they encountered Show The Truth posters. My two-year-old brother was oblivious to the images. My sensitive five-year-old sister and seven-year-old brother were obviously struck by them. My parents gently explained the reality of abortion to them, emphasizing that abortion was evil. They explained that some mommies had their babies killed because nobody had

told them that they were real babies. These pictures were showing that they are real babies so that no one would do this anymore. The little ones listened gravely and were comforted by my parents' calm response, and have since been involved and interested in the pro-life efforts of the family as a whole.

I thank God that I have witnessed Show The Truth. The memory of these pictures has often come back to strengthen me when my pro-life beliefs have wavered in face of the prevalent "pro-choice" ideology in our society. My Show The Truth encounter has also opened the door for me to an active and joyful participation in the pro-life renewal."

"BUT CHILDREN SHOULDN'T SEE THESE IMAGES"

Please note that our target audience is not children, but adults who do not realize how horrifying abortion is. Yet it is not possible to completely avoid having children see the images.



The problem of children being upset is a concern of ours, too. But the problem of children being dismembered is an even greater concern. We are faced with a situation in which stopping the killing involves upsetting the living. Which do you care more about?

Our activity here saves children's lives. Children may get upset, for example, when the sirens of fire engines, ambulances, or police cars come into their neighbourhood. But we comfort them by explaining that people are being helped and lives are being saved. We have all had to explain hard things to our children, such as the events of September 11. The images themselves don't harm children, particularly when they have parents who take the time to answer their questions. In fact, we have had parents bring their children to participate in showing the images to the public! And the children do so with pride.

We believe in handling first things first. Let's stop the killing of our children by abortion. Then we can comfort the survivors.
